Education Programs, Fees & Schedule Middle & High School Field Studies 2016-2017

Programs: The current programs offered for Middle (6th – 8th) and High School (9th – 12th) Each program is an in-depth field study and will last the entire visit – Please choose one.

Wetland Ecology: field and lab studies, water quality, macro invertebrate collection and identification, and plant identification.

Plants – The Workhorse of the Wetland: field studies, plant identification, water filtration, interactive dichotomous key use

Wildlife Management (WM): history, purpose, benefits and types of Wildlife Management practices will be discussed. Current WM practices in the Wetland and at the Center will be explored using hands-on exploratory field practices.

Blue Gold – A Path to Water Conservation: hands on water conservation activities, urban water cycle, nonrenewable resource, water as it relates to those living in Texas and on site tour of conveyance pump station, the last step in the filtration process.
