Your school can be a Field Experience site! During this two hour program, a JBS team member will use your school site to guide students in a program in one of following areas:

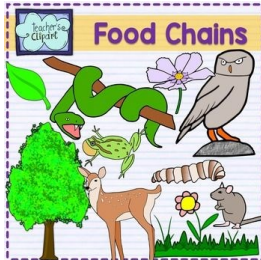


Water Ecology - Do you have a water source near your school that is accessible to your students (i.e. pond, stream, ditch etc...)? One of our team members would love to come out and give your students a water ecology lesson in the comfort of their own school grounds.



Birds: They are Everywhere! - No matter where you are, you are sure to have birds close by. We will bring binoculars and all the materials necessary to have bird lesson outdoors using your school grounds as an outdoor classroom. Bird adaptations and migration will be part of the class.

Wildlife Ecosystems - No matter how urban your habit may be, wildlife is all around you! Our team will bring everything needed to use your school grounds to teach students about the wildlife ecosystem that is right in their own backyard. Energy flow and transfer, and food webs and chains are also covered during this class.



Wasting Water is Weird - Water Conservation - During this lesson students learn that water is a non-renewable resource, and how to make informed choices regarding the conservation of water. The hands-on activities focus on the urban water cycle process and human water consumption. Students will participate in a model of the urban water cycle, predicting the effects of water usage in the future and how their use of water can be a factor.
