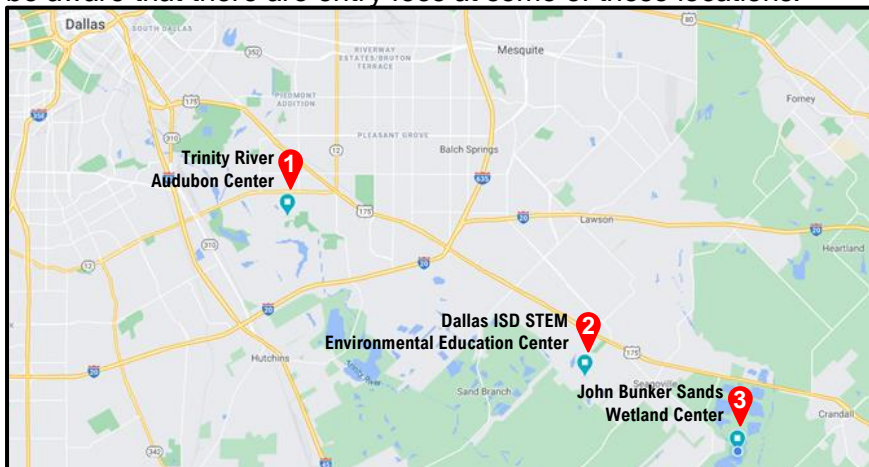
All Trinity Trifecta Champs will be entered in a drawing for one of **these** fabulous prizes! Winners will be announced August 3rd.
